



Donkeys are known to be able to carry heavy loads. Thankfully, God makes our heavy loads lighter because He is always with us (Matthew 11:29-30).

### YOU WILL NEED:

- 2 Jar Lids
- Small Wooden Skewer
- Craft or Popsicle Sticks
- Paint
- 2 Wooden Clothespins
- Diagonal Cutters
- Paintbrush
- Thick Construction Paper
- Hot Glue Gun
- Cardboard
- Sturdy White Paper



### DIRECTIONS:



1. Glue craft sticks onto a 3" x 4" piece of cardboard.



2. Cut 4 craft sticks in half.



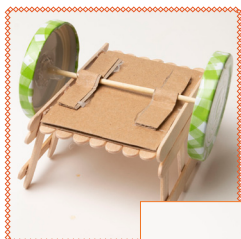
3. Line up 4 half sticks and glue 2 craft sticks over them near the top and bottom. Repeat for the other railing.



4. Glue railings to the bottom edge of the cart on both sides.



5. Hot glue a 4 1/2" dowel to the inside center of the lids.



6. Glue 2 strips of 3" x 1/2" cardboard over the dowel to hold the axle in place, loosely enough to allow wheels to turn freely.



7. Glue 2 craft sticks to the front of the cart, leaving about 1" gap between them.



8. On a sturdy 6" x 4" paper, draw the donkey head and body. Paint and cut out.



9. Paint the cart and the clothespins. Glue a 5" x 1/2" piece of construction paper to the cart shafts. Let dry.



10. Fasten the clothespin legs to the body. Hang the cart on the donkey's back. Your donkey and cart are ready!
