

Killdeer often pretend they are injured especially while protecting their young. Chicks need to follow their parent's instructions because their nests are close to the ground and are vulnerable to predators (Proverbs 19:20).

YOU WILL NEED:

- Cardstock Paper
- Black Sesame Seeds
- White Sesame Seeds
- Yellow Split Peas
- Black Beans

DIRECTIONS:

- Buckwheat
- Crayons
- School Glue
- TweezersBlack Marker
- Pencil
- Brush
 - Toothpick
 - Googly Eye





1. Fold an $8\frac{1}{2}$ " x 11" sheet of cardstock paper in half to make a card. Then draw a frame near the border of the card.



4. Apply glue to the small banded areas on the head and throat. Carefully press on black sesame seeds. Let dry 15 minutes. Apply glue to the rest of the bird and press on the white sesame seeds.



2. Draw the outline of the killdeer in the center of the frame.



5. Cut a toothpick in half and color it with black marker. Glue in place to make the beak. Let dry. Color a background.



3. Glue a googly eye. Apply glue liberally to the desired surface. Pour buckwheat, press down a little. Glue black beans on the legs. Use tweezers if needed. Let it dry about 15 minutes.



6. Glue yellow split peas around the frame. Let dry for 15 minutes. The killdeer card is ready.
