YOU WILL NEED:

- Cardboard Box or Shoebox
- 2 Large Round Plastic Containers
- Matching Fabrics

- Jute Cord
- Clothesline
- Scissors
- Ruler
- Hot Glue Gun
- Craft Knife




DIRECTIONS:



- 1. Cut off the top flaps from the cardboard box. Hot glue the corners. Hot glue the bottom.
- 2. Measure the height of the box and add 3". Measure the perimeter of the box. Cut out a strip of fabric according to these 2 measurements. Wrap the fabric around the inside of the box, folding over 2" to the outside and gluing with hot glue. Hot glue the lower edge of the fabric to the inside bottom of the box.
- 3. Cut out a piece of cardboard the same size as the bottom of the box. Cut out a piece of fabric the same size as the cardboard, adding a 1" seam allowance all around. Glue the fabric to the cardboard, folding the extra fabric over and hot glue in place.
- 4. Hot glue the fabric-covered cardboard inside the bottom of the box.



5. Cut out a piece of fabric that is the same size as the length and width of the box plus 2" on each side.





9. Alternately wrap clothesline and jute around the rings.



10. Hot glue the wrapped rings to the sides of the box.
