### YOU WILL NEED:

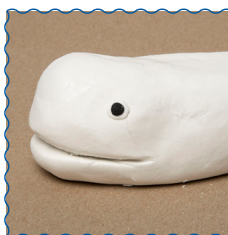
- Air Dry Modeling Clay
- Black Modeling Material
- Dowel
- Putty Knife



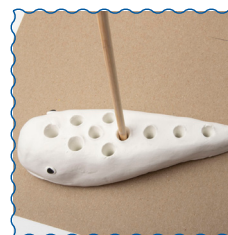
### DIRECTIONS:



1. From a 2.2 pound package of modeling clay, cut off a large piece; mold it into a long triangle for the body. Form it into the streamlined shape of a beluga whale.



2. Make the eyes by forming a small ball of white modeling clay; then add a piece of black material on top. Use a putty knife to shape the mouth.



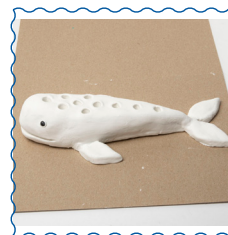
3. Make a few holes on the back of the beluga with the dowel. The holes should be large enough to fit pencils, pens, and brushes.



4. Make two leaf-shaped pieces from clay and attach them to the beluga for the tail flukes. Smooth the clay well along the seam.



5. Roll out two flippers from clay. Attach them to the beluga and seal well.



6. Lay the beluga on a flat surface. Smooth all the surfaces with a damp wipe. Let air dry for 24 hours. You can use your unique beluga pencil holder on your desk to impress your friends at school.
