



BRAVE HEARTS

Let's be brave like Jonathan was in 1 Samuel 14:16.

YOU WILL NEED:

- Poster Board
- Hemp Cord
- Red Cardstock
- White Cardstock
- Nail Scissors
- Scissors
- Old DVD Disk
- Thin Cardboard
- Pencil
- Ruler
- Glue Stick
- Hot Glue Gun



DIRECTIONS:



1. Cut out 4 hearts and a circle from poster board according to the pattern on the next page.



5. Glue the red hearts over the poster board hearts.



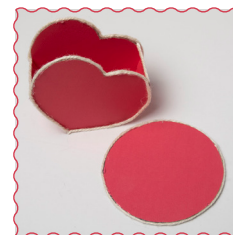
9. Glue the poster board and red cardstock circles to the disk.



2. Cut out another 4 hearts and a circle from red cardstock. Cut 1 heart from white cardstock.



6. Rest the first heart on its side. Line up the cardboard strip so it will be even on both sides. Glue the cardboard strip to the bottom and side edges of the heart, red side facing inward. Glue the paper edge of the strip to the outside of the heart.



10. Hot glue cord or twine trim on all the edges of the heart box and disk.



3. Cut an 8x3" strip of thin cardboard, cutting across the ridges. Carefully cut 1/2" strips down both sides of the cardboard strip, not cutting all the way through. Remove the top layer, with its channels, all the way down to the smooth paper.



7. Glue the second heart to the cardboard strip, lined up with the first heart, red side inward.



11. Draw letters for the word BRAVE on the white cardstock heart. Cut the letters out. Glue them onto the red heart box.



4. Bend the cardboard strip. Make cuts through the paper along both sides of the cardboard.



8. Glue the other two hearts to the front and back of the box with the red side out. Cut out strips of red cardstock and glue them over the outside and inside of the cardboard strip.



12. Hot glue the heart box onto the red disk, resting the heart on its side. Done!
