



Sin broke the heart of God; let's ask Him daily to give us a clean heart to do His will (Psalm 51:10).
Craft this soap as a reminder to keep your hands and heart pure.

YOU WILL NEED:

- Aluminum Foil
- White Soap Base
- Transparent Soap Base
- Glass Measuring Cup
- Red Food Coloring
- Scissors
- Craft Sticks
- Microwave
- 1 Aluminum Can ⚠
- Craft Knife ⚠



DIRECTIONS:



1. Cut off the top and bottom of the aluminum can.



5. Place a few pieces of soap base into a glass measuring cup. Place in the microwave for 20-30 seconds.



Alternative

1. If it's not possible to make heart molds from an aluminum can, place some scrap pieces of soap into a glass measuring cup. Place in the microwave for 20-30 seconds.



2. Cut the remaining aluminum roll into three rings.



6. Pour a few drops of red food coloring into the melted soap. Stir. Pour it into the heart mold. Let it cool.



2. Pour melted soap into any flat mold.



3. Carefully bend the ring into a heart shape.



7. Remove aluminum foil. Remove any bits of soap from the outside of the mold.



3. Take out the cooled soap. Carve it into the shape of a heart with a knife.



4. Lay the heart on a piece of aluminum foil. Fold the edges of the foil up and slightly over the edges of the heart mold. If the foil gets a hole in it, just start over.



8. Carefully remove the soap from the mold. Use the heart mold a few more times. If desired, you can carve the soap into a more rounded shape.



4. Make several different colors and shapes of hearts from either the transparent or the white soap base using different food coloring.
