



Noah's family found favor with God because of his devotion to the LORD (Genesis 7:1). Noah's life affected not only his family, but also the animals that went into the ark. Imagine how kind Noah must have been to each of God's creatures!

YOU WILL NEED:

- Colored Pencils* • Paper
- Colored Marker* • Scissors
- Pencil* • Glue Stick
- Paperclips
- Flat Pliers



DIRECTIONS:



1. Print out the pages in the attachment on a color printer. You will need one copy of Noah and his family and two copies of the animals.



5. With the pliers, bend the single loop end of the paperclip up at a 90° angle.



9. Make enough holders for Noah, his family, and all the animals.



2. Cut out the printed sheets along the solid lines and fold them along the dotted lines.



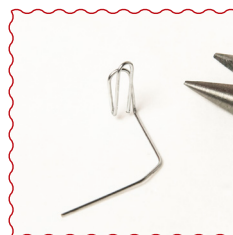
6. Bend the smaller inside loop of the other end up to the first bent loop. Squeeze together with pliers.



10. Insert the paper figures into the holders.



3. Glue the folded parts together. Cut them out, leaving a border of white around any fine details.



7. Unbend the long end.



11. After you're done playing with them, you can store the figures in the ark that you made. Isn't God's love for all His creation amazing?



4. Make sure to leave enough room at the bottom edge for the paperclip. The front and the back will look the same.



8. Bend the long end of the paperclip into a flat triangle, moving it to where it can support both the front and the back of the holder.

* You only need these if you need to make or color your own people and animals.
