

Rabbits rely on their keen sense of hearing for safety. God has given us ears to hear His Word. He is asking each one of us to open the door of our heart and let Him come in (Revelation 3:19-20).

YOU WILL NEED:

- Pink Embroidery Floss
- Black Embroidery Floss
- 2 White Pipe Cleaners
- 2 Small Black Beads
- Uncooked Dry Rice
- Chunky Chenille Yarn
 Ribbon
- 1 Big Sock Needle
- Roll of Tape
- Thread
- Scissors



DIRECTIONS:



1. Slip the top of the sock up through the hole in the tape roll. Turn the edges down over the ring.



5. Straighten the top of the sock. Cut it in half down the middle.



9. Sew on two black beads for eyes. Embroider on a pink bunny nose and black eyebrows.



2. Pour the rice through the ring into the sock until it is about 2/3 full.



6. Cut the ends of the ears, shaping them to a point.

7. Bend two pipe cleaners

one together at the bottom.

10. Cut three pieces of chunky yarn. Sew two pieces on for arms.



3. Wrap several layers of thread around it to close it tightly and knot the thread. Repeat this a few times, then snip off any excess thread.



4. Pour more rice through the ring into the sock, adding about half the amount as before. Wrap it tightly with thread close to where the heel begins. Tie a knot. Do not cut off the

extra thread this time.



8. Sew the ends of the rabbit's ears to the pipe cleaners. Cut off the excess.

11. Wrap the third piece of chunky varn in a spiral and sew it to the back for a fluffy tail.
