

The disciples didn't fully understand that Jesus would rise again, yet in spite of their sorrow, they were hopeful as they ran with eagerness to see the empty tomb. (John 20:4.)

## YOU WILL NEED:

- 1 10" Bowl
- Forest Moss
- Stones
- Spanish Moss
- 3 12" Dowels
- Paint Brush
- Paint
- Rubber Bands
- Plastic Grocery Bags
- Flat Stone 4" Diameter
- Diagonal Cutters



## **DIRECTIONS:**

1 4" Flowerpot



1. Paint the inside of the flowerpot black.



2. Paint the outside of the pot the same color as the stones.



6. Put the flowerpot on its side in the top of the basket and cover it with Spanish



**3.** With cutters, cut 4" from the end of each dowel. Using these as the crosspiece, fasten with rubber bands to make crosses.



7. Place the three crosses into the moss in the background. Put stones around the entrance to the tomb. Place the flat stone at the entrance.



4. Paint the crosses.



8. Tuck some forest moss around the edges of the bowl. The empty tomb is ready. Jesus has risen from the dead!
