



Fall for JESUS

Even though we stumble and fall short of our Lord's perfect plan,
He will guide our steps and pick us back up (Psalm 37:23-24).

YOU WILL NEED:

- Faux Fall Leaves
- Paper Napkins
- Cardboard
- Scissors
- Paint
- White Cardstock
- Floral Wire
- School Glue
- Markers
- Pencil
- Fall Decorations
- Wooden Beads
- Jute Cord
- Brushes
- Cutters
- 2 Small Craft Clothespins
- Heavy Thread
- Ribbons
- Ruler
- Hot Glue



DIRECTIONS:



1. From cardboard, draw and cut out 3 identical outlines of a pumpkin with a stem, approximately 20" x 20". Stack and glue the cardboard together.



2. Glue paper napkins to the entire top surface of the pumpkin and around the edges, but not over the stem. Let dry well.



3. Paint the pumpkin white. Let dry. Apply some paint to the pumpkin to color it as you like.



4. Make four garlands by stringing wooden beads together with heavy thread. Paint two garlands brown and the other two golden yellow.



8. Tie a ribbon bow.

5. Hot glue the garlands onto the pumpkin. Hot glue two small clothespins at the top of the pumpkin below the beads.

6. Wrap jute cord around the pumpkin stem. Use hot glue to secure it.

7. Attach a small sheet of white cardstock with the clothespins. Glue on faux fall leaves at the bottom of the pumpkin.



9. Glue on the bow and fall decorations at the bottom of the pumpkin.



10. Tie a loop of jute cord. Glue it to the back of the pumpkin below the stem.



11. Wrap jute cord around some floral wire. Glue the ends of the cord to the wire. Twist the wire into tendrils and glue it on the pumpkin's stem.



12. Draw some autumn-themed decorations on the piece of white cardstock, then write on it: **Fall for Jesus. He never leaves.** Clip it to the pumpkin with clothespins.
