



GIVING GLORY

Many compared Paul and Barnabus to powerful gods, but the two of them held fast and insisted that God, and God alone, deserves all the glory (Acts 14:15).

YOU WILL NEED:

- 11" x 14" Canvas Panel
- 1 Small Black Bead
- Colored Cardstock
- Poster Board
- Colored Markers
- Masking Tape
- Paper Egg Carton
- Colored Pencils
- Paint
- Scissors
- Paint Brush
- Aluminum Foil
- Hot Glue Gun



DIRECTIONS:



1. Draw the silhouette of a rooster, approximately 5" x 6", not including the tail. An example is in the attachment. Cut out the body of the rooster from poster board.



2. Add volume to the rooster with foil.



3. Cover the entire surface of the foil with pieces of masking tape.



4. Cut out long feathers for the tail and feathers for the wing from colored cardstock. Cut out scallop-shaped pieces for the body. Cut out several long, thin pieces for the neck.



5. Hot glue the colorful feathers to the tail.



6. Hot glue two colors of scallop-shaped pieces to the entire body up to the neck.



7. Glue the long, thin strips around the rooster's neck.



8. Cut the head, comb, beak, wattles, and legs out of the egg carton. Color all the pieces.



9. Hot glue the rooster to the middle of the canvas board. Hot glue the wing in place.

10. Hot glue on the pieces for the head, comb, wattles, beak, and a bead for the eye of the rooster.

11. Hot glue the legs. Draw the claws and spurs.

12. Write this phrase on the canvas: "RISE AND SHINE AND GIVE GOD THE GLORY."
