



GLORY TO GOD

YOU WILL NEED:

- Thick, Cream-colored Thread
- 2 Wooden Balls 1½"
- 10-12 Dowels 12"
- White Feather
- Tape
- 3 White Pipe Cleaners
- 2 Wooden Beads ½"
- Cloth Stem Wire
- Poster Board
- Pencil
- Curly, Fluffy Yellow Yarn
- Glitter Paper or Foam
- Thin Silver Ribbon
- Jute Cord
- Ruler
- White Lace, Trim, Ribbon
- Twisted White Twine
- Nylon Stockings
- Cardstock
- Cutters
- 2 Styrofoam Balls 1½"
- Thin Wooden Sticks
- 4 Pony Beads
- Scissors
- Hot Glue
- Black and Red Markers
- Compass & Pencil
- Colored Felt
- Threads

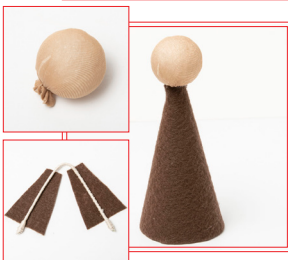


DIRECTIONS:

1. Cut out a semicircle from cardstock with a 4-5" radius (see attachment). Roll into a cone and fasten with tape. Repeat to make three cones.



2. Hot glue brown felt over one of the cones. Pull the nylon stocking over a Styrofoam ball. Gather with thread at the bottom and trim off excess material. Cut off the tip of the cone and hot glue the head to the cone.



3. Cut a 6" piece from the cloth-covered wire. Wrap it with thick, cream-colored thread, adding more thickness at the ends. Hot glue on some pieces of felt to make sleeves. Hot glue the arms to the cone. Make more felt clothing for the shepherd. Draw on the eyes and mouth. Make a staff by wrapping wire with jute. Glue the staff to the shepherd's hand.



4. For the two angels, glue any white fabric, lace, trim or ribbon to the cones. Cut off the tip of the cones. Glue a 1½" wooden ball to each cone. Twist the three pipe cleaners together. Cut into two 6" pieces. Hot glue pony beads to the ends. Hot glue the arms to the cones.



5. Cut 10-20 pieces of white twine of 10" long. Unravel the twine. Tie a knot around the middle of the strands.



6. Hot glue the hair of the first angel. Cut out wings from glitter paper. Hot glue fluffy yarn around the edges. Glue the wings to angel. Draw on eyes and mouth.

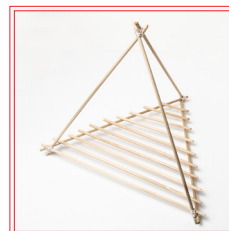


7. For the second angel, cut many small pieces from yellow yarn.



9. Glue the white wing feathers to the angel's back. Draw on the eyes and mouth.

10. Cut the other Styrofoam ball into two halves. Glue on the wooden beads. Glue curly yarn over the surface of the Styrofoam pieces. Insert and hot glue four thin wooden sticks to each. Draw eyes and hooves.



11. Using six wooden dowels, hot glue a pyramid together. Hot glue pieces of dowel across the floor of the pyramid.



8. Spread plenty of glue over the scalp area of the second angel. Roll the head in yellow pieces of yarn. Let dry. Remove any excess from face.



12. Cut out a tag from cardstock and write: "Glory to God" on it. Glue to frame. Cut out a star from glitter paper and glue to the top.
