- White Lace, Trim, Ribbon
- 2 Styrofoam Balls 11/2"
- · Black and Red Markers
- 2 Wooden Beads 1/2"
- Glitter Paper or Foam
- Twisted White Twine
- Thin Wooden Sticks
- Compass & Pencil
- 10-12 Dowels 12"
- Cloth Stem Wire
- Thin Silver Ribbon
- Nylon Stockings
- 4 Pony Beads
- Colored Felt
- White Feather
  Tape Poster Board
- Jute Cord
- Cardstock
- Scissors
- Threads
- Pencil Ruler
- Cutters








## DIRECTIONS:



1. Cut out a semicircle from cardstock with a 4-5" radius (see attachment). Roll into a cone and fasten with tape. Repeat to make three cones.









5. Cut 10-20 pieces of white twine of 10" long. Unravel the twine. Tie a knot around the middle of the



eyes and mouth. 7. For the second angel, cut many small pieces from yellow yarn.





9. Glue the white wing feathers to the angel's back. Draw on the eyes and mouth.

10. Cut the other Styrofoam



of the Styrofoam pieces. Insert and hot glue four thin wooden sticks to each. Draw eves and hooves.



11. Using six wooden dowels, hot glue a pyramid together. Hot glue pieces of dowel across

the floor of the pyramid.





8. Spread plenty of glue over the scalp area of the second angel. Roll the head in yellow pieces of varn. Let dry. Remove any excess from face.



12. Cut out a tag from cardstock and write: "Glory to God" on it. Glue to frame. Cut out a star from glitter paper and glue to the
