YOU WILL NEED:

- Scissors
- Ruler
- Pencil
- Cardboard
- Green Foam Sheets
- Liquid Chalk Marker
- Craft Knife
- Hot Glue Gun
- Wooden Numbers 1-5



DIRECTIONS:



1. Cut out a tree trunk about 6' high from cardboard. The base and top of the tree should be about 12" wide, and the middle portion 6" - 7" wide.



6. Glue green foam sheet to the cardboard treetop. Cut off the excess. With liquid chalk marker, write **Growing with Jesus**.



2. Several pieces of cardboard can be glued together to make the trunk the right size.



7. Cut out a few leaves from foam and glue them on the treetop. Glue the treetop to the top of the tree.



3. Make a mark with liquid chalk marker on the left side of the tree, starting at 1 foot high. Continue marking white lines in 1" increments that are 1" in length. At each foot, make the white line 2" long.



8. Once the glue is dry, clip or hang the tree on a wall. The base of the tree should be placed at floor level. Grow with Jesus and mark your height on the tree each year.



4. Glue the wooden numbers next to each foot mark.



5. From cardboard, cut out a treetop about 12" x 16".
