



Palm trees are a reminder that, like in Matthew 21:6, we also can say, "Hosanna in the highest!" Jesus is our king, too, and He will deliver us!

YOU WILL NEED:

- Green Masking Tape
- Wire
- Scissors
- White Poster Board
- Floral Wires
- Stones
- Jute Twine
- Diagonal Cutters
- Plastic Container
- Red Pen
- Soft Foam Material
- Hot Glue Gun



DIRECTIONS:



1. Cut 4-6" of floral wire. Apply green masking tape on both sides, leaving 1½" of the wire free on the end.



5. Attach 20 palm leaves to the other end of the wire. Hot glue jute twine around the trunk of the palm tree.



9. Cut off a few pieces of jute twine and fluff them into a mat of fiber. Set aside.



2. Taper the ends of the leaves with scissors. Make cuts along the edges to look like a palm leaf.



6. Wrap jute twine around the plastic container using hot glue.



10. Curl and spread the leaves on the palm tree. Cover soft foam material with the jute fiber. Tuck a few palm leaves into the pot under the palm tree.



3. Make about 25 palm leaves.



7. Stand the palm tree in the container. Put some rocks in the bottom.



11. Fashion a stand-up card holder from wire. Carefully write the word "Hosanna" on a piece of poster board. Insert it into the holder.



4. Bend two 18" pieces of floral wire in half to make the trunk. Bend ½" of the ends of the wire sideways.



8. Fill the entire container tightly with soft foam material.



12. Palm tree is ready to provide leaves for the greeting of Jesus: "Hosanna in the Highest!"
