**YOU WILL NEED:**

- Red Paper
- Scissors
- Wire
- White Eggs
- Paint
- Pencil
- Paint Brush
- 2 Googly Eyes
- Hot Glue Gun 
- Diagonal Cutters 



**DIRECTIONS:**



**1.** Carefully poke a hole in the bottom of the egg and drain out the insides.



**2.** Bend the wire to make the stand as shown in the picture.



**3.** With a pencil, draw the outline of a penguin on the egg.



**4.** Place the egg on the stand with the wire inside the egg. Then, paint the penguin black behind the outline.



**5.** Glue on the eyes and paint on a beak.



**6.** Cut four feet out of the red paper.



**7.** Set egg aside. Glue two feet pieces together over the wire at the base of the stand to make one foot. Repeat for the other foot.



**8.** Place the egg back on the stand with the wire inside the egg and glue the penguin egg into place over the feet. Penguin is ready.
