## YOU WILL NEED:

- Cardboard
- 2 Small Plastic Lids
- School Glue
- Metal Ruler
- Masking Tape
- Paint
- Pencil
- Scissors
- Brush
- Colored Paper
- Craft Knife
- Hot Glue



## **DIRECTIONS:**



1. Out of cardboard cut: 6 pieces 20"x8" and 4 pieces 8"x73/4". Cut and round one corner on 4 of the larger pieces, making them all the same.



5. Cut out narrow strips of cardboard: 4 pieces ½"x7½". 2 pieces ½"x8". Cover them with masking tape. 6. Lay out the long




9. From cardboard cut: 2 pieces 7"x7½", 4 pieces 7"x2½", 4 pieces 6½"x2½". Glue two of each matching piece





2. Double the pieces by gluing together so you end up with 2 pieces with one rounded corner, 1 long rectangular piece, and 2 squares. The final thickness of the pieces should be about 1/4".



3. Wrap masking tape around the outer edges as shown in the picture.
