



# Prayer on Fire

Elijah's faith led him to immediately obey God, even when things seemed impossible (1 Kings 18:38). Help was always just a prayer away.

## YOU WILL NEED:

- 3 Cups of School Glue
- 3 Tablespoons Baking Soda
- 6 Tablespoons Saline Contact Lens Solution (with boric acid)
- 1 Medium Mixing Bowl
- Measuring Cups and Spoons
- 3 Wooden Sticks for Stirring
- Red and Yellow Food Coloring
- 3 Glass Jars with Lids
- Yellow Cardstock
- Orange Cardstock
- Red Cardstock
- Scissors
- Black Marker



## DIRECTIONS:



1. Pour 1 cup of school glue into the bowl. Add 1 tablespoon of baking soda. Drop in 10-15 drops of yellow food coloring.



2. Stir the resulting mixture well until it is smooth.



3. Pour 2 tablespoons of saline solution over the mixture. Stir. The resulting mass will stretch like slime.



4. Put the slime in a jar.



5. Pour 1 cup of school glue into a bowl. Add 1 tablespoon of baking soda. Drop in 10 drops of yellow and 10 drops of red food coloring. Stir the resulting mixture well until smooth.



6. Repeat steps #3 and #4 to finish making the orange slime.



7. Pour 1 cup of school glue into a bowl. Add 1 tablespoon of baking soda. Drop in 10-15 drops of red food coloring. Stir the resulting mixture well until smooth.



8. Repeat steps #3 and #4 to finish the red slime.



9. You should have three jars of slime: yellow, orange, and red.



10. Cut out three small ovals from colored cardstock. Write on them "LORD, HEAR OUR PRAYERS", "HELP IS A PRAYER AWAY", and "THE LORD - HE IS GOD".



11. Stick the labels to the jars.



12. If you take some of each color of slime and pull and stretch it together, you can make it look like flames of fire.
