YOU WILL NEED:

- Glow in the Dark Cord
- White Liquid Chalk Marker
 Hot Glue Gun
- Black Cardstock
- Glue Stick
- Paper
 - Scissors

- Ruler
- Pencil

DIRECTIONS:



1. Put your hand, with fingers together, on a sheet of paper. Trace around it with a pencil and cut it out.



5. Turn both hands over. Glue more cord on just the right and left edges of this side.



2. Using the paper as a pattern, cut out four hands from black cardstock.



6. Place the palms together. The sides facing outward should be the ones completely outlined with cord. Glue fingers together.



9. Write these 5 words on the ring: PETITION, CONFESSION. INTER-**CESSION, THANKS-**GIVING, PRAISES. You could also print the words out and glue them onto the ring.





3. Use a glue stick to glue two sets of hands together. Place both hands facing each other.



7. Cut two strips of black cardstock approximately 12" x 2".

11. Now you can write a prayer request and slip it between the fingers of the praying hands.



4. Hot glue the cord around the outline of the hands and fingers.



8. Glue one strip into a ring. Glue the bottom of the hands to the ring opposite each other. Glue the other strip around the outside of the first ring.



12. Even in the darkest times, God is always eager to hear your prayers.
