



Pufferfish earned their name because of their incredible ability to puff up their entire body in self-defense. Being “puffed up” is a term used to describe being prideful, which is bad for our character. Let’s be careful not to be “puffed up!”

YOU WILL NEED:

- Poster Board
- 1 Styrofoam Ball (4")
- 2 Googly Eyes
- School Glue
- Paper Napkins
- Hot Glue Gun
- Toothpicks
- Scissors
- Cutter
- Pencil
- Cord
- Paint
- Brush
- Foil



DIRECTIONS:



1. Roll up a piece of foil 3½” long into a tube. Twist it into a ring. Glue the ring onto the Styrofoam ball.



2. Cut out the fins and tail for the fish from poster board. Glue them to the ball.



3. Tie a loop of cord and glue it to the top of the fish.



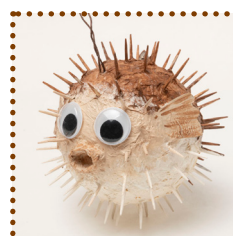
4. Break the toothpicks in half and stick the toothpick halves over the entire surface of the fish, except the eye area. Place a bead of hot glue at the base of the toothpicks to secure them to the ball.



5. Use school glue to apply paper napkin layers to all surfaces of the fish. Let dry.



6. Paint the fish. Let dry.



7. Glue the eyes to the fish, and it’s done. Your pufferfish can remind you to always be humble.
