



SABBATH GLOBE

On the seventh day, God rested from His work of creation (Genesis 2:2-3).
He invites us to rest in Him each Sabbath day.
Make a nature globe to celebrate God's handiwork!

YOU WILL NEED:

- Glass Jar with Lid
- Distilled Water
- Blue Food Coloring
- Plastic Aquarium Plants
- Permanent Marker
- Sheet Protector
- Manicure Scissors
- Small Glass Bowl
- Glitters
- Glycerin
- Small Rocks
- Seashells
- Wooden Stick
- 3D Paint
- Hot Glue Gun



DIRECTIONS:



1. Remove any stickers from the jar and wash the jar, lid, rocks and shells well with soap and water. Rinse and dry well.



2. Choose a selection of plants that will fit the jar. Wash the plants and let dry.



3. Glue the plants, rocks and shells to the inside of the lid without touching the rubber seal of the lid. Be sure to check that the lid can be screwed on well.



4. Using 3D paint, draw several colorful fish, a jelly fish, an octopus and some seahorses on the sheet protector. Let dry 24 hours. Add details with a permanent marker. Cut out.



5. Glue the marine creatures you made to the leaves of the plants.



6. Pour distilled water into the jar. Add 3 or 4 tablespoons of glycerin to the water.



7. Add one drop of blue food coloring to the bowl. Dip the tip of the wooden stick into the blue coloring and stir it into the water in the jar. The water should be slightly blue.



8. Pour blue, silver and gold sparkles into the jar. Mix well.



9. Screw the lid onto the jar. If the water doesn't reach the top, add more water. Make sure the lid is on tight.



10. Shake the jar and turn it over. The glitter will slowly sink to the bottom. Enjoy your view of the underwater world God made for us!
