



WELCOME SIGN

Abraham showed hospitality to visitors, and didn't realize his guest was a heavenly Visitor as we find in Genesis 18:3-5. Will you show kindness to those who enter your home?

YOU WILL NEED:

- Colored Cardstock
- Poster Board
- Hole Puncher
- Scissors
- Pencil
- Pony Beads
- Cord
- Glue Stick



DIRECTIONS:



1. Print the page with letters from the attachment or draw the letters "WELCOME" approximately 4" high. Cut them out.



6. Fold a 20" piece of cord in half, string 16 or 17 beads on it and knot the end, leaving the loop on top. Make two more.



2. Using these letters for a template, cut out the "WELCOME" letters from poster board.



7. Attach the beads by passing the loops through the hole in the bottom of the "E".



3. Cut out two more of each letter from colored cardstock and glue them to both sides of the poster board letters. Allow to dry and trim excess.



8. Cut out a 15" piece of cord and attach it to the top of the "W" for a hanger.



4. Punch a hole in the top and bottom of each letter, close to the center of balance.



9. Your welcome sign is now ready. Hang it up to welcome your guests!



5. Cut 6 strands of cord 4" long. Tie the letters together, leaving about 1" between them.
