## YOU WILL NEED:

- Newspaper
- School Glue
- Cardboard
- Paints
- Brushes
- Water
- Ruler
- Pencil
- Round Balloon
- Colored Paper
- Small Bowl
- Red Marker
- Masking Tape
- Wooden Skewer
- Lid from Shoe Box
- Hot Glue Gun 〈8)



## DIRECTIONS:



1. Cut squares of newspaper $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 1 \frac{11 / 2 " \text {. Inflate }}{}$ the balloon to $81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ in diameter.

2. Cut out a semicircular strip of cardboard 8 " tall, $12^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ long and $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " wide. Also cut out two foot pieces according to the pattern in the picture, complete with notches to fit them together.

3. Glue a layer of newspaper squares, covering the balloon completely. Thin the glue with a little water and paint the entire surface with the glue. Let dry and repeat 5 or 6 times.

4. Put tape over the edges of the cardboard semicircle for a smooth finish. Paint it or cover it with colored paper. Write a message on it.

5. Wind tape around the bottom end of the skewer to hold the globe in place.
6. Paint the continents and the oceans.

7. Paint the ball white and allow to dry. Pierce completely through the ball with the skewer at the North and South poles. Draw the outline of the continents on the ball.
8. Mount the semicircular piece to the foot, using hot glue.

9. Paint the box cover or cover it with colored paper.

10. Glue both ends of the skewer to the semicircular support, in such a way that the globe can spin freely. Glue the foot to the shoe box lid. The globe is ready!
