



Paul was spared from the poisonous snake to be a witness to others.
 Most poisonous snakes have elliptical pupils and broad heads.

YOU WILL NEED:

- Black Poster Board
- Red Paper
- School Glue
- Googly Eyes
- 3 Paper Towel Rolls
- 1 Toilet Roll
- Glue Stick
- Scissors
- Black Paper
- Ruler
- Wire
- Awl ⚠
- Yellow Paper
- Pencil
- Wooden Dowel
- Plier Cutters ⚠



DIRECTIONS:



1. Cut each paper towel roll into 4 equal parts. Glue a strip of black paper around each piece. Make a curvy yellow strip of paper to glue down the top of each piece.



2. With scissors, round all four corners of each piece, except for one. On the one piece, cut only the top corners. This piece will attach to the head.



3. To make the tail, shape a toilet roll to a point, and glue the top and bottom tips together. Cover with black paper and add a yellow strip.



4. Cut wire into 12 pieces that are 2" long. Make loops by twisting around a dowel, leaving 1/2" ends. (Dowel only for shaping).



5. Carefully make a hole with the awl in the ends of the rolls so they can be fastened together with the wire clips.



6. Insert clips into the holes, joining two pieces together.

7. On the inside, twist the ends of the clips in opposite directions to fasten. Repeat to fasten 12 rolls and the tail together.



8. Draw and cut out the head according to the pattern shown. Also cut 1 strip of poster board 2 1/2" x 1", and 2 strips that are 1" x 1/2". Make tongue and teeth from colored paper.



9. Bend up the ends of the larger strip of poster board and glue these flaps inside the last roll (the one not rounded on one end).



10. Fold the flaps of the head piece. Glue the head to the strip of poster board on the snake body. Fold the 2 strips of poster board and glue them to the top of the head for eye-mounts. Glue on the eyes, teeth, and tongue.



11. You can twist the snake into any position. Please do not try to scare your brothers and sisters.
