### YOU WILL NEED:

- White Feathers
- Black Feathers
- Blue Colored Paper
- Cardstock Paper
- Yellow Foam Sheet
- Black Foam Sheet
- Blue Color Pencil
- Utility Knife
- Pencil
- Googly Eye
- Cotton Ball
- Scissors
- School Glue



### DIRECTIONS:



1. Draw the outline of the eagle in the center of a 8½" x 11" sheet of cardstock paper.



4. Apply glue on all remaining areas of the head except the beak. Place the white feathers on, starting from the bottom.



2. Using the utility knife, shave pieces from the core of the blue pencil onto the paper around the eagle. Rub shavings into the paper with a cotton ball.



5. Draw, then cut out the beak from yellow foam and the nostril out of black foam. Glue into place.



3. Apply glue to the bottom of the neck and apply the black feathers as shown.



6. Glue the beak, the nostril and the eye. Cut four strips of blue paper and glue them around the edges to make a frame. The eagle is ready!
