



Elephants are good at remembering people and things, and they always do better when working together. When we work together, it not only sharpens our minds, it encourages us to serve God through helping others (Acts 2:44).

YOU WILL NEED:

- Old Newspaper
- White Paper
- Construction Paper
- Gray Paint
- Black Marker
- Scissors
- School Glue



DIRECTIONS:



1. Spread out newspapers to protect your work surface.



4. Let the paint dry thoroughly. Cut out the handprints. (Upside-down, the handprints look like elephants.)



2. Have an adult paint both of their hands with gray paint, then you do the same with your hands.



5. Using the marker, draw their eyes, ears, and toenails. Draw "wrinkle" lines on the knees and along the trunk (thumb).



3. While the paint is still wet, press your hands down on the white paper, leaving a complete handprint.



6. Glue elephant on construction paper. Draw the elephant's tail, and you're done!
