### YOU WILL NEED:

- Construction Paper
- 2 Toilet Paper Rolls
- 4 Plastic Bottle Caps
- Pipe Cleaners
- Wooden Dowels
- Black Paint
- Paint Brush
- Cord
- Twine
- Glue Stick
- 2 Googly Eyes
- Awl
- Scissors



### DIRECTIONS:



1. Use one toilet paper roll for the body, and half a toilet paper roll for the head. Glue construction paper on the inside and outside of the rolls.



2. Cut out ears, tail, and tongue from construction paper. Decorate the body and pieces as you would like. Glue the eyes, ears, and tongue to the head. Make the nose by pushing a small piece of pipe cleaner through the roll at the edge of the head.



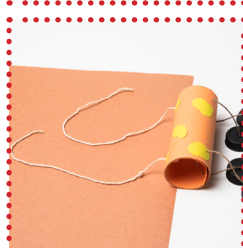
3. Take a 9" and a 5" piece of dowel and fasten them together in the shape of a cross using a pipe cleaner.



4. Make a hole in the top of each of the four plastic bottle caps and paint them black.



5. Make four holes in the body tube for the legs. Cut two 8" pieces of cord. Tie a knot at one end, and thread the other end up through one lid, through the front two holes, and down through the other lid. Fasten with a knot. Repeat for the back legs.



6. Make two holes at the top of the body, one at the front and one at the back. Cut two pieces of twine twenty inches long. Make a knot in one end and pass the twine up through the hole from the inside. Repeat for other hole.



7. On the front twine, tie a knot 1" above the body. Make 2 holes at the back of the head, one directly above the other. Slide the head over the twine, and attach both pieces of the twine to the wooden dowel cross. Adjust the twine length so the puppy stands evenly on its paws.



8. The puppy is ready to be a friend for you!
