## **YOU WILL NEED:**

- Purple Fabric
- Green Craft Felt
- Brown Craft Felt
- Foam Sheet
- Cotton Balls
- Thread
- Needle
- Jute Twine
- Ruler
- Pencil
- Wire
- Plier Cutters
- Hot Glue Gun 🔇



## **DIRECTIONS:**



**1.** Cut a 3" circle of fabric. Sew gathering stitches around the edge.



**2.** Put a cotton ball in the middle of the circle. Tighten the thread and tie it in a knot.



**3.** Repeat steps 1 & 2, making approximately 30 grapes.



**4.** Cut a triangle from a 4" x 4" **5.** Ginch piece of foam. Curl the sides together forming a cone. Glue the edges and fill with cotton balls.



**5.** Glue the grapes onto the cone with hot glue gun.



**6.** Cut green leaves from felt. Cut thin strips of brown felt. Make a knotted loop from jute twine.



7. Cut a 6" piece of wire. Wrap a brown felt strip around the wire, gluing with hot glue.



**8.** Glue one of the leaves to a brown strip of felt, then glue it to a cluster of grapes.



**9.** Glue the cluster of grapes and leaves to the vine.



**10.** Glue the jute twine loop to the vine for a hanger. Done!
