## YOU WILL NEED:

- Gray Yarn
- Gray Felt
- White Yarn
- 2 Googly Eyes
- Black Yarn
- Poster Board
- Key Ring
- Ruler
- Scissors
- Hot Glue Gun



## **DIRECTIONS:**



1. Cut out two 3" circles from poster board, and two 1½" circles. Make cuts in the circle as shown. Place the matching circles on top of each other.



2. Wrap the gray yarn evenly around the large circles. Wrap 3-5 times around the smaller circles with black, then continue with gray for two layers.



3. Wrap a layer of white yarn around each circle.



**4.** Carefully cut the yarn around the middle where the two pieces of poster board meet.



5. Work a strand of gray yarn between the two circles and knot tightly around the yarn, then knot again on the other side. Bring the ends of the yarn up through the gray part of the pompom.



**6.** Remove the poster board circles. Trim any long strands, but leave the ends of the yarn you tied it with.



**7.** Cut two ears from the gray felt.



**8.** Glue the small pompom to the large pompom for the muzzle. Glue on the eyes and ears.



**9.** Glue a strand of black yarn to the muzzle to make a mouth.



**10.** Tie a keyring to the strands of gray yarn. Hope your wolf isn't deceitful!
