YOU WILL NEED:

- Red Paper
- Paint
- Scissors
- Pencil

Paint Brush

White Eggs

- 2 Googly Eyes
- Hot Glue Gun
- Wire
- Diagonal Cutters





DIRECTIONS:



1. Carefully poke a hole in the bottom of the egg and drain out the insides.



2. Bend the wire to make the stand as shown in the picture.



3. With a pencil, draw the outline of a penguin on the egg.



4. Place the egg on the stand with the wire inside the egg. Then, paint the penguin black behind the outline.





6. Cut four feet out of the red paper.



7. Set egg aside. Glue two feet pieces together over the wire at the base of the stand to make one foot. Repeat for the other foot.



8. Place the egg back on the stand with the wire inside the egg and glue the penguin egg into place over the feet. Penguin is ready.
