YOU WILL NEED:

- Red Paper
- Paint
- Scissors
- Pencil
- White Eggs
- Paint Brush
- 2 Googly Eyes
- Hot Glue Gun ⚠
- Wire
- Diagonal Cutters ⚠



DIRECTIONS:

	<p>1. Carefully poke a hole in the bottom of the egg and drain out the insides.</p>		<p>5. Glue on the eyes and paint on a beak.</p>
	<p>2. Bend the wire to make the stand as shown in the picture.</p>		<p>6. Cut four feet out of the red paper.</p>
	<p>3. With a pencil, draw the outline of a penguin on the egg.</p>		<p>7. Set egg aside. Glue two feet pieces together over the wire at the base of the stand to make one foot. Repeat for the other foot.</p>
	<p>4. Place the egg on the stand with the wire inside the egg. Then, paint the penguin black behind the outline.</p>		<p>8. Place the egg back on the stand with the wire inside the egg and glue the penguin egg into place over the feet. Penguin is ready.</p>
