

Frogs sit on the bank of the pond, resting in God's sunshine. As children of God, we can bank on His goodness as stated in Psalm 103:2-5. God's promises make me LEAP for joy!

## **YOU WILL NEED:**

- Green Felt
- Black Marker
- Red Felt Ruler
- Scissors Utility Knife
- 2 Green Plastic Bottles
- 2 Green Plastic Lids
- 2 Large Googly Eyes
- Hot Glue Gun



## **DIRECTIONS:**



1. Cut around one green bottle 2" from the bottom to make a cup for the head, and the other bottle 21/2" from the bottom to make the body.



2. From the green plastic, cut 6 toes (2" x 11/2"), 2 plastic strips (5" x 11/2"), 2 smaller plastic strips (2½" x ½"), and 2 hands with 4 fingers (1" x 1").



3. Cut out 4 squares of green felt, 4" x 4". Cut a coin slot in the middle of each. Hot glue 2 squares together, lining up the slots. Repeat for the other 2 squares.



4. Hot glue the felt squares over the top of the bottle cups that you cut out. Let dry. Trim off excess felt.



5. Cut out the tongue from red felt (3" x 1") and hot glue it to the body inside the mouth.



6. Hot glue the eyes to the bottle caps and hot glue them together side by side. Hot glue them to the top of the head.



7. Hot glue 3 toes together in a fan shape. Hot glue both ends of one long green strip to the side of the body at the bottom. Hot glue the feet on. Repeat for the other side.



8. Hot glue the short strips to the front of the body at the top. Attach the hands.



9. Hot glue a small strip of green felt at the back to join the head to the body.



10. The frog is ready! Now you can save up coins for church or to help a friend.
