



Olive oil was used for both food and light during the time period in which God, through Elisha, helped the widow. Aren't you glad that we are reminded in Philippians 4:19 that God will take care of all our needs?

YOU WILL NEED:

- Clay
- Water
- Small Dowel
- Sponge
- Rolling Pin
- Roller
- Small Bowl
- Toothpick



DIRECTIONS:



1. Moisten the clay as needed and mix well. Roll a 1" and a 1½" ball from the clay.



2. Shape the larger ball into an oval bowl of even thickness. Roll out the smaller ball into an oval lid the same size as the bowl. Cut a circle in the middle and cut a small piece out of the edge.



3. Moisten and score the edges of the bowl and lid.



4. Carefully place the oval onto the bowl and smooth the seam well, using a little water as necessary to help it stick.



5. Shape the lamp, making sure the nose of the lamp is raised enough to keep the oil in.



6. Smooth the surface of the lamp with water. Using the toothpick or stylus, make decorative marks in the clay.



7. Make a handle from clay. Attach it well, using water as necessary.



8. Let dry thoroughly. The lamp is ready!

Adult required: A parent may place the lamp in a fireproof container. Then add wick and oil before lighting.
