



ANNOUNCING ANGEL

The angel came to shepherds and invited them to accept Jesus as their Savior, as it says in Luke 2:10-11. Will you accept Jesus into your heart?

YOU WILL NEED:

- Plastic Bottle
- 3" Foam Ball
- White T-shirt
- Yellow Yarn
- Dried Grain
- White Paint
- Paint Brush
- White Thread
- 2 Googly Eyes
- Twine
- Scissors
- Ruler
- Tape
- Ruler
- Red Paper
- Corrugated Cardboard
- 1 White Pipe Cleaner
- Floral Wire 18"
- Hot Glue Gun



DIRECTIONS:



1. Pour the grain into the bottle. Cover the ring at the top of the bottle with tape.



2. Cut out a 22" x 22" piece of t-shirt material. Place the bottle in the center of the square and bring the fabric up around it, gathering evenly. Tie tightly at the neck with thread.



3. Fold the top ends of the fabric down and trim excess.



4. Cover the foam ball with another piece of t-shirt fabric, 12" x 12". Tie tightly with thread.



5. Wrap the floral wire with twine, gluing in place with hot glue. Bend the ends into loops to make hands. Slide a 2" circle of fabric over each end and secure at the wrists with twine.



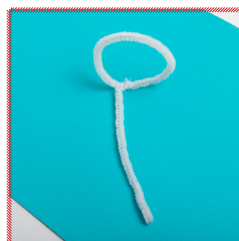
6. Push back the folds of fabric around the ball to apply hot glue to the inside center. Attach it to the body. Trim the excess material to make a frill on the angel's neck. Glue arms to the body.



7. Cut out two 6" x 8" wings from the corrugated cardboard. Paint lightly with white paint, allowing some of the cardboard color to show through.



8. Cut 20 to 30 pieces of yellow yarn 12" long. Secure them with a knot around the middle.



9. Fashion a halo from the white pipe cleaner.



10. Tie a bow around the angel's neck with twine. Glue the hair, halo, eyes, and wings on. Cut a heart from the red paper and place it in the angel's hand. Your angel is ready to announce the good news!
