

In Matthew 2:11, the Magi came bearing gifts for baby Jesus. Create and share these spice ornaments with others to spread the love of Jesus.

• Cutting Board

• Sugar Pearls

YOU WILL NEED:

- Applesauce
- Ground Cinnamon
- Cookie Cutters

DIRECTIONS:

- Rolling Pin
- Baking Sheet • Measuring Cup

• Plastic Wrap

1. Pour 1 cup cinnamon into a bowl.

- Parchment Paper
 - Gold Cord Bowl
- Spoon
 - Straw
 - Scissors
 - Oven



5. Place another sheet of parchment over the dough. Roll out the dough to 1/4" thickness. Carefully remove the top paper.



2. Pour 1 cup applesauce into the bowl with the cinnamon.





3. Mix well until it forms a ball of dough. If too thin, add more cinnamon; if too dry, add applesauce.





4. Place a sheet of parchment paper on your work surface. Sprinkle with a bit of cinnamon. Place a ball of dough on the paper and sprinkle with more cinnamon.



6. Cut out shapes with the cookie cutters. Peel away excess dough. Make a hole in each ornament with the straw.



7. Transfer the ornaments to a parchmentlined baking sheet. Decorate with sugar pearls. Bake at 200 degrees for about 2 hours, or let them air-dry for 2 days until completely dry.



8. Tie a piece of gold cord to each ornament. Share these little spice gifts with someone!
