



SERVING RETRIEVER

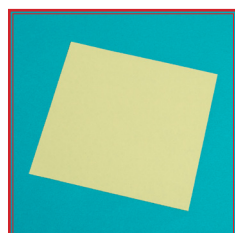
In Mark 10:45 Jesus made it His purpose to serve.

YOU WILL NEED:

- Yellow Paper
- Glue Stick
- Scissors
- Grosgrain Ribbon
- Brown Paper
- Black Marker
- Pencil
- 2 Googly Eyes
- Double-sided Tape
- Red Marker
- Ruler
- Brown Crayon



DIRECTIONS:



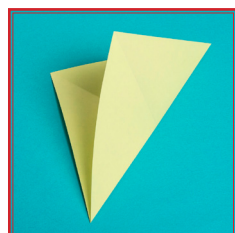
1. Cut a 5" x 5" square of yellow paper. Try to make it as exact as possible.



5. Valley fold the paper in half.



9. Fold the tip down to the crease. Reverse all the folds of the face to make the paper more flexible. Work the folds until you have the little square for the nose in position. Flatten the folds.



2. Fold in half diagonally; first one direction, then the other. (valley fold)



6. Fold one end up, lining up the tip with the top crease.



10. Bend the corners of the ears down and tuck the point of the nose under as shown. Put a little piece of double-sided tape inside near the top to help the head keep its shape.



3. Fold two opposite corners to the center where the folds cross.



7. Bend one side of the flap down, lining up the side with the bottom crease. Open out the fold you just made.



11. Cut out two bones from brown paper. Glue them together with the end of the ribbon between.



4. Turn the paper over. Bring the fold you just made to the center line and crease. Repeat for the other side.



8. Repeat for the other side.



12. Color and draw the ears and facial features. Glue the eyes on. Glue the other end of the ribbon to the back of the head. You now have a bookmark to place in your favorite book!
