



TRUSTING HEARTS

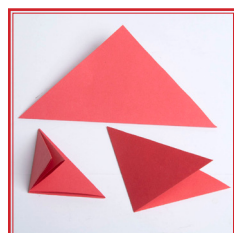
We, too, can have faith as the nobleman whose son was healed by the words of Jesus. Will you trust the Lord with all your heart, as it says in Proverbs 3:5-6?

YOU WILL NEED:

- Construction Paper
- Paper Clips
- Glue Stick
- Black Marker
- Scissors
- Pencil
- 1 Skewer
- Pen



DIRECTIONS:



1. Fold a 5" x 5" square of construction paper in half diagonally. Fold the resulting triangle in half. Fold the triangle in half again.



5. Use a 2½" x ½" piece of yellow construction and fold in half. Cut out the shape of a bee's body. Draw the stripes and head with marker. Fold and glue the body onto a paper clip. Make 1" x 1½" wings and glue them in place.



2. Cut out around the outside edge to make half a heart shape. Open out.



6. Fold the heart-flower to close it up again.



3. Repeat with a smaller piece (3" x 3") of white paper and glue it inside the first one, matching the folds. Write on it "Trust in the Lord with all your heart" (Proverbs 3:5).



7. Clip the bee onto the heart. Glue the leaves to the stem. Glue the stem to the back of the heart.



4. Wrap a strip of green paper around a skewer to create a thin tube of paper. Glue the ends, removing the skewer. Cut out leaves.



8. When you remove the bee, the heart will blossom into a flower. Repeat the steps to make a whole bouquet of heart-flowers with inspiring messages of trust inside!
