YOU WILL NEED:

• Binder Clip Sandpaper

• Ruler

• Scissors

- Black Pen Toothpicks
- Cotton Swab
- Branch

- Paint (black, blue, white, yellow, green, brown, gray)

Paint Brushes

- Dense Styrofoam
- Thin Foam Sheet
- Hot Glue Gun
- Utility Knife 💔
- Diagonal Cutters



DIRECTIONS:



1. Cut from Styrofoam: 2 pieces 12" x 1" x ½" and 7 pieces 7" x 1" x ½". Cut one end of each of the seven sticks to a point.



2. Score the foam pieces with a toothpick to make it look like woodgrain. Smooth all the pieces lightly with sandpaper.





make a light gravishbrown color. Paint all the pieces. Let it dry. Use black and gray paint, add woodgrain details.

4. For nails, break pieces of toothpick and insert them into the foam where the boards meet. Trim off excess. Paint the nails with brown paint.



5. Glue the fence together. Glue the branch to the fence.



6. Remove the loops from the binder clip. Hot glue them to the back of the top board for hangers.



7. Cut out four bird bodies and 4 tails from foam. Sand all parts with sandpaper.

8. Paint with blue and yellow paint. Let it dry.



9. Apply black paint. Let it dry. Paint the small details with white paint. Use the end of a cotton swab to paint the eyes.

10. Glue birds in between the fence and the branch so that they sit close to each other.





11. Cut out 10 leaves from the thin foam sheet. Paint them areen. Let drv. Draw veins on the leaves with a black pen.

12. Glue the leaves to the branch. A flock of friendly birds will delight your family!
