



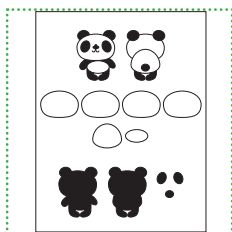
Sometimes just a little helpfulness can make a big difference. The Bible says in Galatians 6:2 that we should “bear one another’s burdens.” Your panda bear bag clip can “bear” the burden of keeping what’s in the bag fresh for you.

YOU WILL NEED:

- Black Foam Sheet
- White Foam Sheet
- Nail Scissors
- Black Marker
- Quilter’s Pencil
- Pencil
- 2 Googly Eyes
- Printer Paper
- Large Binder Clip
- Metal Clip or Clothespin
- Hot Glue Gun



DIRECTIONS:



1. Draw a silhouette or use template* of a panda about 2" x 2½".



2. Cut two panda silhouettes from the black foam sheet.



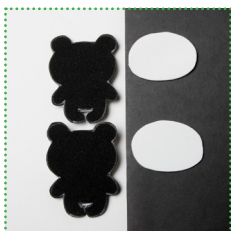
3. From the white foam, cut out two panda heads, one belly and one back. Glue as shown.



4. Cut out the two eye patches and one tail. Glue as shown.



5. Glue on the eyes. With black marker draw the nose and mouth.



6. Turn both panda pieces over. Cut out two more panda heads from the white foam sheet.

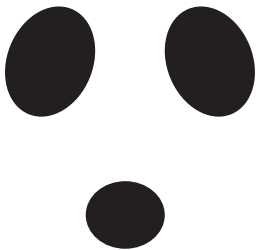
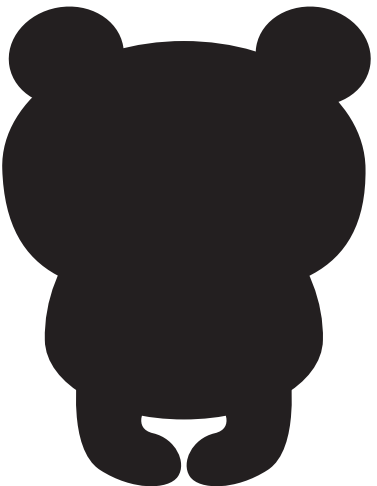
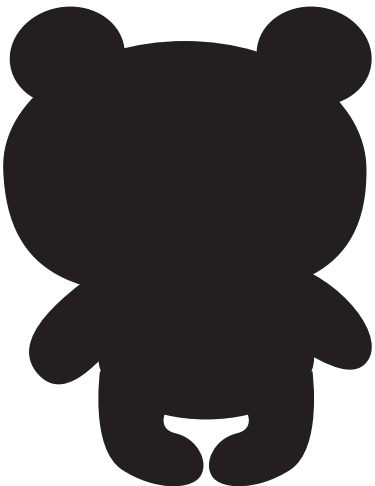
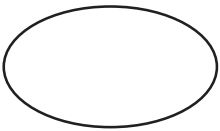
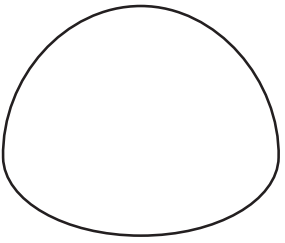
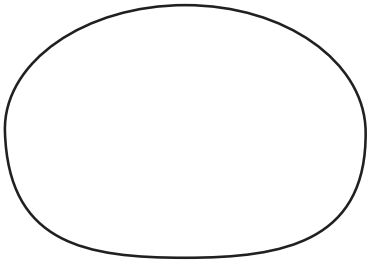
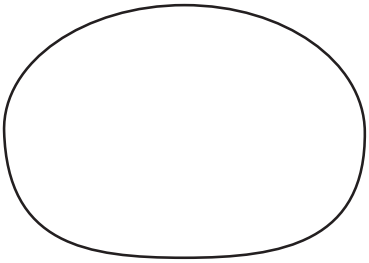
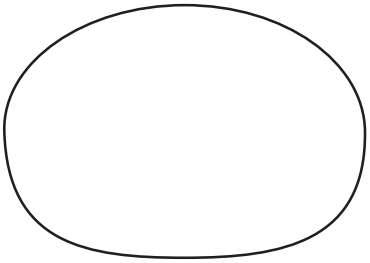
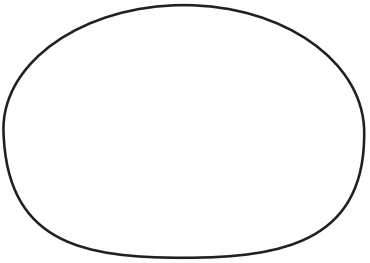
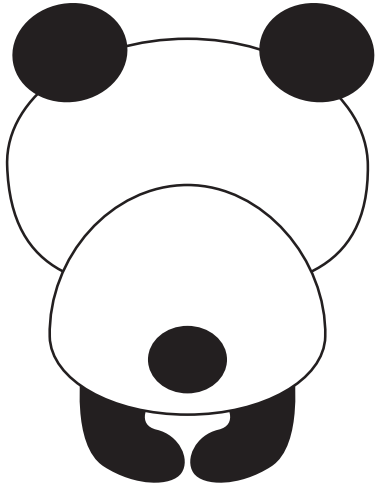


7. Attach the two white pieces to the back of the head, gluing only around the edge and leaving the bottom free for inserting the clip.



8. Slip the finished panda pieces over the ends of the clip to decorate any style clip that will come in handy for you.
