YOU WILL NEED:

- Small Plastic Bottle
- Yellow Poster Board
- White Poster Board
- White Paper
- Thin Wire
- Paint Brush
- School Glue
- Craft Knife
- Hot Glue Gun
- Diagonal Cutters
- Bead
- Pencil
- Paint



DIRECTIONS:



1. With a craft knife, carefully remove the neck of the bottle.



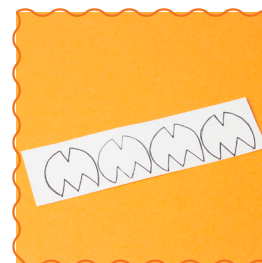
2. Cut a 2" circle from the white paper. You can make cuts in the edge to make it easier to attach.



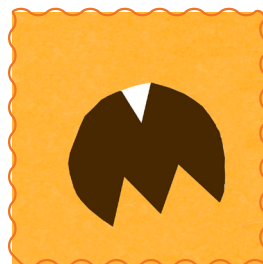
3. Glue the circle over the hole in the top of the bottle.



4. Paint the bottle and the bead. Let dry.



5. Draw 4 paws on the white poster board as shown, with 2 notches in the front and 1 in the back.



6. Paint them and cut them out.



7. Bring the edges of the rear notch together and glue.



8. Glue the bead in place for a nose and make whiskers from wire and attach. Glue on the paws. Draw on eyes and a mouth.



9. Draw glasses on the yellow poster board and cut them out. Fold and place over the mole's eyes.



10. The mole is ready to take a walk or dig a tunnel!
