YOU WILL NEED:

- Newspaper
- Brush
- Foil
- Black Marker
- Foam Sheets
- Floral Wire
- Paint
- Silk flower
- Hot Glue Gun
- 2 Googly Eyes
- School Glue
- Scissors
- Ric Rac Trim
- Diagonal Cutters
- Awl
- Paintbrush
- Ruler
- Black Button



DIRECTIONS:



1. Crumple some newspaper into four balls that are 1", 1½", 2", and 3" sizes. Wrap them in foil and roll them on the table to smooth any irregularities.



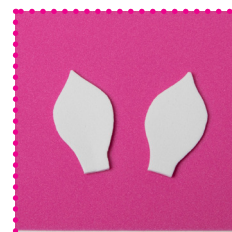
2. Wrap the 1" and 2" balls together and mold into a pear-shaped head. Repeat with the 1½" and 3" balls to make the body.



3. Using the awl, pierce a few guide holes on the head and body for the horns, legs, neck, and tail. From the floral wire make four legs, two horns, a neck, and a tail and glue them in place.



4. Tear the newspaper into small pieces. Glue the pieces over the entire body. Let it dry.



5. Cut out two ears from white foam. Puncture holes for the ears. Pinch the bottom of the ears and insert them. Glue well.



6. Paint the goat with white paint. Paint on "clothes" in your favorite color. Paint the hooves black.



7. Make a ruffled skirt and collar from foam.



8. Glue the skirt and collar to the body. Add a piece of ric rac over the seams. Wrap a piece of foam around each of the goat's knees.



9. Glue on googly eyes and a button for the nose. Use black marker to draw the mouth, eyelashes, and eyebrows. Decorate the head with a flower if you like.



10. Gleeeful goat is ready! You can make different clothes for the goat using your imagination. They will be great to entertain your friends!
