



FAMILY TREE

All throughout the Bible, God shows us the importance of our families and ancestry. How much more precious is the blessing of knowing we belong to the family of God! (Ephesians 3:14-15)

YOU WILL NEED:

- Branches or Twigs
- 4" Flowerpot
- Colored Cardstock
- Brown Yarn
- Decorative-edge Scissors
- Double-sided Tape
- Black Marker
- Family Photos
- Glue Stick
- Clothespins
- Scissors
- Floral Foam
- Ruler
- Moss
- Pencil
- Stones



DIRECTIONS:



1. Tie several branches together with brown yarn to make a tree.



5. Write your family name on a 13" long strip of cardstock twice. Fasten it to the flowerpot with double-sided tape. Tuck some moss around the base of the tree.



9. Glue the face onto the circle and the circle to the oval. Write the person's name underneath.



2. Place a few stones at the bottom of the pot for weight and stability.



6. If the branches are too long, cut out a section of the branch, then fasten the tip back on with some brown yarn.



10. Using double-sided tape, adhere a clothespin to the back of each oval photo frame.



3. Place the tree in the middle of the pot. Fill the pot with floral foam so that the tree will be steady.



7. Collect photos or prints of each of your family members.



11. Make oval frames for all your family members. You can use different colors of cardstock.



4. The tree should have plenty of branches. If you find you need more branches, simply unwind your tree bundle, add more twigs, and rewind.



8. Using decorative-edge scissors, cut out a 3½" x 2½" oval and a 2" circle from colored cardstock. From the photo, cut out a 1" circle of your family member's face.



12. Attach all photos to the tree. You can also make a beautiful inscription for the pot.
