



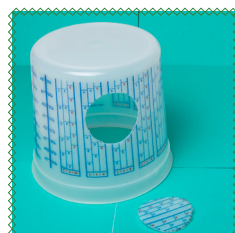
God wants us to create peace in our home like it says in Psalm 122:7.
Will you do your best to create peace in your home like Abram?

YOU WILL NEED:

- Brown Tape
- Green Tape
- Artificial Greenery
- 4 Washers $\frac{3}{8}$ "
- 1 Carriage Bolt $\frac{5}{16}$ "
- Nut
- Plastic Bucket
- Thick Stick
- Black Marker
- 2 Zip Ties
- Scissors
- Card Board
- Ruler
- Hot Glue Gun
- Awl
- Craft Knife



DIRECTIONS:



1. Turn the bucket upside-down. Draw a hole about $2\frac{1}{4}$ " in diameter about 2" from the closed end of the bucket. CAREFULLY cut out the hole.



5. Cover the entire surface of the bucket with tape. Cut the tape that is covering the hole and tuck the edges of the tape inside.



9. Cover a 10" x 8" piece of cardboard with green tape, covering well on all sides. It will be a roof for the birdhouse.



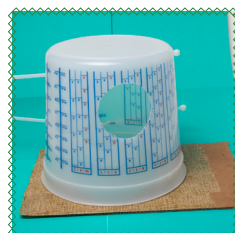
2. Cut two sets of small holes on the opposite side of the bucket and thread two zip ties through them.



6. Decorate the surface of the bucket as you wish. Underneath the 2" hole, CAREFULLY make a small $\frac{1}{4}$ " hole.



10. Glue the roof on the top of the birdhouse. Secure it with tape. Wrap green tape over the bolt several times.



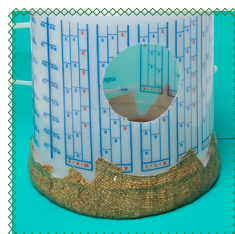
3. Cover an 8" x 8" piece of cardboard with brown tape. Hot glue the cardboard to the open end of the bucket. Trim edges of the cardboard.



7. Thread the bolt through the small hole from the inside. Place the washer and nut over the bolt on the outside and tighten down well.



11. Tape some artificial greenery to the birdhouse. Attach a thick stick to the birdhouse with the zip ties. Cut off excess.



4. Seal the cardboard to the bucket using plenty of tape so it adheres well.



8. Fold a small piece of cardboard into a wedge. Cover it with green tape. Glue it well on the roof of the birdhouse. Secure it with tape too.



12. Place the birdhouse on a tree or on a pole for our feathered friends to enjoy. If you wish, spray it with a water shield to make it last longer outside.
