




Unlike Eli's sons, we want to follow Micah 6:8: "to do (ACT) justly, LOVE mercy, and to WALK humbly with your God."

YOU WILL NEED:

- Black Poster Board 22" x 28"
- Double-sided Tape
- Flat Oval Platter
- White Paint Marker
- Light Gray Paint
- White Paint
- Yellow Paint
- Cardboard
- Hemp Cord
- Black Marker
- Paper Towels
- Paintbrush
- Pencil
- Sponge
- Craft Knife 



DIRECTIONS:



1. Pour some light gray paint into the platter. Place your left palm into the paint in the platter.



2. Using the sponge, spread the paint evenly over the palm and fingers of your hand.



3. Make a handprint at the top of the black poster. Repeat with other hand. Wash your hands well with warm water and soap.



4. Place your feet into the paint.



5. Make prints of both your feet on the bottom of the black poster. Wash your feet well in warm water and soap. Be careful not to track the paint around.



6. Paint a heart in the middle of the black poster with light gray paint. Touch up the gaps a bit on the handprints and footprints. Let dry.



7. Write **ACT** in yellow paint over the handprints, **LOVE** on the heart, **WALK** on the footprints. Write the words: **justly**, **mercy** and **humbly** with white paint marker in-between. Touch up with black marker so it shows up over the gray paint.



8. Cut off long strips of cardboard. Fasten the strips on the back of the poster around the edges using double-sided tape.



9. Attach the hemp cord to the back of the poster for a hanger.



10. The poster is ready!
