YOU WILL NEED:

- Black Permanent Marker
- 4 Octagonal Mirrors 5" x 5"
- 1 Round Mirror 5" x 5"
- Cardboard
- Ruler
- Pencil
- Scissors
- Scotch Tape
- Twine
- Paper
- Craft Knife
- Hot Glue Gun



DIRECTIONS:



1. Cut out two 6½" x 6½" squares from cardboard. Cut two vertical grooves the full height of the cardboard on the left and right sides. Lay one end of the twine in each groove. The twine in between should be a little loose. Loose ends should hang out the bottom.



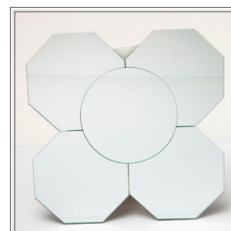
2. Pour hot glue into the grooves with the twine inside. Immediately glue the second piece of cardboard over the first piece of cardboard.



3. Carefully remove anything projecting from the back of the mirrors. Place the 4 octagonal mirrors exactly even horizontally and vertically.



4. Hot glue cardboard with the twine in the middle of the 4 the octagonal mirrors. Knot the ends of the twine. Glue the ends of the twine to the bottom edge of the cardboard and mirrors. Trim off the excess. The twine at the top must be free.



5. Carefully flip the mirrors over. Hot glue the round mirror in the middle, but closer to the top than the bottom.



6. Lay two sheets of paper for guides at the top and bottom edges of the place where the word **REFLECTION** will be written. Tape the sheets to the mirror. Write "**REFLE**" on the bottom left mirror, spacing the letters evenly. On the bottom right mirror, write "**CTION**" starting from the middle.



7. Using the template, write the word **REFLECTION** on the mirrors with black permanent marker. Then remove sheets of paper.



8. Write the remaining words from the phrase "**Be a REFLECTION of Jesus**" on the mirrors as shown. Hang the mirror in place. Each time you look at it, the mirror will remind you of the character of Jesus.
