YOU WILL NEED:

- 2 Pairs of Short White Socks
- 1 Black Sock
- Black Fabric Marker
- White Felt
- Black Felt
- Black Thread
- White Thread
- Needle
- Pencil
- Fiberfill
- Scissors
- White Yarn
- Black Yarn




DIRECTIONS:



1. Draw black zebra stripes on two of the socks.



2. Cut off the tops of the socks, making one a little bigger than the other. These will be the head and body.



5. Cut out the legs and turn them right side out. Stuff with fiberfill. Sew up the open ends and draw on the stripes.

6. Cut out two small cones from the white socks for the ears.




9. Cut two rectangles from felt (one white and one black).



10. Make narrow cuts along the long edges to make a fringe.



3. Stuff the socks with fiberfill and sew them up.



7. Cut out eyes and eyelashes from black and white felt.



11. Fold in half and secure with thread.



4. Turn the other two socks inside out. Draw on them the outline of four legs. Stitch over the lines, leaving the top ends open.



8. Sew the ears and eyes to the head. Cut the toe from the black sock and sew it over the nose, turning the edge under as you go. Sew the head and legs to the body.



12. Sew the mane to the back of the head and body. Braid a tail and sew it to the body. Zebra is ready!
