

FLUTTERING Butterfly



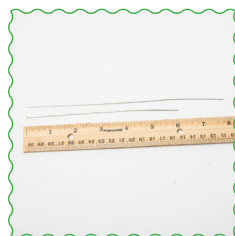
Butterflies flutter from flower to flower, spreading pollen to create new life. Jesus wants us to "go and tell" the good news of His resurrection (Matthew 28:10), helping others to find eternal life.

YOU WILL NEED:

- Thin Colored Paper
- Colored Markers
- Elastic Band
- Ruler
- Wire
- Scissors
- Skewer
- Dowel
- Narrow Tape
- Pencil
- Cutters
- Pliers



DIRECTIONS:



1. Cut off two pieces of wire, one about 6" and the other about 8".



5. Make bends in the other end of the wire as shown in the picture.



9. Cut out four butterfly wings from colored paper the same length as will fit on the wires.



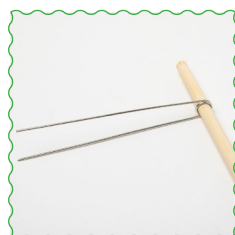
2. Make a loop in the middle of the shorter wire by bending it around a skewer.



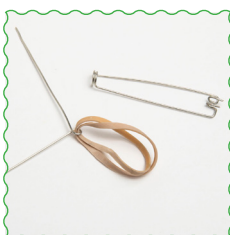
6. Bend the tips downward to make two hooks in the ends.



10. Decorate the wings. Tape the top wings to the wires first.



3. Bend the middle of the longer wire in a complete circle around the dowel. The loop in the shorter wire should pass freely through the ring.



7. Thread the elastic through the small loop in the short wire.



11. Temporarily remove the elastic band from the hooks. Tape on the bottom wings. Put the elastic band back on the hooks.



4. Bend the ring at a 90 degree angle to the ends of the wire using pliers.



8. Pass the ends of the elastic on the loop through the ring and slide the ends over the hooks.



12. While holding the bottom of the butterfly with one hand, wind up the top wings with the other hand. Hold the butterfly up and let go. Butterfly will fly!
