

The goal of walking through a maze is to follow the right path that leads to the way out!

When we choose to follow the plan that God has for our lives,

He promises to make the path straight (Proverbs 3:5-6).

YOU WILL NEED:

- Double-thick Cardboard
- X-acto Knife
- Hot Glue Gun
- וג
- Glue StickCraft Knife

Metal Ruler

- Pencil
- MarkerScissors
- 1" BallPaper
- ConsocioCompass



DIRECTIONS:



1. Cut out two 11" x 11" squares of double-thick carboard.



2. Draw lines on one of the squares, marking a ¼" border around the edges. Draw a maze inside the square. Draw a few circles slightly larger than the ball.



3. Ask an adult to help you cut out the circles with an X-acto knife.



4. From double-thick cardboard, cut out 4 strips 2½" x 11¼" and 6-8 strips 1" x 11".



5. Glue the 1" wider of cardboard on top of the edge lines of the maze. Glue pieces of 1" strips strips over the maze lines.



6. Glue the four 2½" strips of cardboard to the outer edges of the other 11" square, to make the base.



7. Cut out a 1" x 1" square in the front wall of the base.



8. Glue two narrow strips of cardboard (must be wider than the ball) inside the base on the right and left sides.




9. With marker and paper, write the words: START, FINISH. Cut out and glue them to the beginning and end of the maze. Insert the maze into the base.



10. Place the ball on the start and guide the ball to the finish line. If the ball falls into a hole, don't worry, the ball will roll out through the hole. Try again. The Lord will help you reach the finish line!
