

When we choose Jesus as our anchor, we will find life rather than death. (John 10:10)


## YOU WILL NEED:

- Paper Napkin
- White Paint Marker
- Dark Metallic Paint
- Cardboard
- Paper

- Blue Paint
- Paintbrush
- Brush for Glue
- Scissors
- Rope
- Pencil
- Ruler
- School Glue
- Craft Knife



## **DIRECTIONS:**



1. Print out the two sheets in the attachment. Or draw half an anchor on a 20x8" piece of paper.



2. Glue the two sheets together to make half an anchor, overlapping the points and matching the lines.



**3.** Cut out the pattern. Trace around the pattern onto cardboard, flipping it over to complete the whole anchor. Cut out.



**4.** Cut out several identical anchors from cardboard.



**5.** Glue all the anchors on top of each other to make one anchor. The final thickness of the anchor should be approximately 1".



**6.** Glue torn pieces of paper napkin over the entire surface and sides of the anchor. Let it dry.



**7.** Paint the anchor with blue paint. Let it dry.



8. Tint around the edge of the anchor with a dry paintbrush, using the dark metallic paint. Also, apply a little bit of dark metallic paint to the front surface of the anchor.



**9.** Write with white paint marker the words: **JESUS IS MY ANCHOR.** 



**10.** Decorate the anchor with rope!
