

Cats have been known to travel for days and often return. Unlike cats, we have a promise in John 14:1-3 that Jesus will return for us so that we can live with Him.

YOU WILL NEED:

Striped Socks

• Green Felt

• Fiberfill

• Ribbon

Needle
Thread

• 1 Fastener

Black Marker

- Fishing Line
 - 2 Googly Eyes
 - Scissors
- Hot Glue Gun 🤇



DIRECTIONS:

1. Turn socks inside out. Draw the lines as shown. Cut along the lines through both layers. The red line marks the place for the hole. Cut out the hole, cutting only through the top layer.



2. Sew the body along all cut lines. Do not sew the hole. Sew the tail along the long edge. Sew the ears along the edges. Turn all the pieces right-side out.



3. Stuff the body, ears, and tail with fiberfill. Sew the last seams on the tail and ears shut. Fill the head with fiberfill. Gather the material at the bottom with thread to make the head round. Trim off excess material.



4. Sew the ears to the head. Sew the head and tail to the body.



5. Cut out two small circles of green felt. Glue the googly eyes to the felt. Color the fastener with black marker for the nose.



6. Tie a ribbon around the neck. Glue the eyes on. Attach the nose.

7. Tack a bit of the head to the back so it doesn't flop.



8. Cut six 1 inch pieces of fishing line and glue to the face for whiskers. The cat is ready!
